STATIONS OF THE CROSS

What is a beautiful new chapel without the Stations of the Cross?

During my recent trip to the Holy Land, I came across artisans carving statues depicting the Stations of the Cross out of olivewood. I was inspired to bring them to our chapel and to our students.

The olive tree is native to the Holy Land where it has been cultivated since ancient times. According to historians, the first olive groves took root in the Holy Land and along the coast of the eastern Mediterranean around 4,000 B.C.

The olive tree is also connected to our Christian faith. Jesus prayed under an olive tree on his way to Jerusalem after the last supper and before his crucifixion on a cross made of the olive wood taken from the olive trees near the garden of Gethsemane in Jerusalem.
