Audition is Monday morning July 30, 2018

Practices are July 30 - August 4, 2018

Performances 3 PM and 6:30 PM August 4

An audition will be held for the Missoula Children's Theatre (MCT) production of SNOW WHITE AND THE SEVEN DWARFS at the Nebraska City High School Auditorium Monday, July 30, 2018 beginning at 9:30 AM.

Those auditioning should arrive early (9:15 AM) and plan to stay for a full two hours. Some of the cast members will be asked to stay for a rehearsal immediately following the audition that will continue into the afternoon. Packing a sack lunch is a good idea. No advance preparation is necessary for auditions.

Students entering 1st grade through 12th grade are encouraged to audition. Approximately 50 students will be cast in the play. There is no guarantee that everyone who auditions will be cast in the play. **Students must have completed Kindergarten to audition.**

Among the roles to be cast are Snow White, her friends Phineas, Foxy and Fernando, Queen, seven Dwarfs, the Forest animals, Black Forest Creatures, a Magic Mirror, Bats, Henchmen and the King.

Assistant Directors will also be cast to aid in rehearsals throughout the week, and to take on essential backstage responsibilities.

The Missoula Children's Theatre touring productions are complete with costumes, scenery, props and makeup. MCT Tour Actor/Directors will conduct rehearsals throughout the week. Most students rehearse from 10 AM to 2 PM each day. Rehearsals are mandatory. No exceptions.

Rehearsals will be conducted every day at the Nebraska City High School Auditorium in Nebraska City. Although not all cast members will be needed at every session, **those auditioning must have a clear schedule for the entire week and if selected, be able to attend all rehearsals required for their role AND be on time for all rehearsals.** Because so much has to be accomplished during the week before the performance it is critical that students be on time and attentive and in top shape mentally and physically to rehearse. A detailed rehearsal schedule will be distributed at the conclusion of the audition. Cast members scheduled for the full 4 hours of rehearsal will be asked to bring a sack lunch, dinner or snack.

SNOW WHITE AND THE SEVEN DWARFS will be presented two times on Saturday, August 4 at 3 PM and 6:30 PM. Please let family and friends know so they can reserve this date on their calendars. The students in the cast will be called for dress rehearsal Saturday morning. All cast members must be available for that rehearsal and both scheduled performances.
