97% of the Class of 2018 took the ACT. In 2017-2018 the ACT average scores for Lourdes students who took the test were: English 25.2 / Math 21.9 / Reading 26.4 / Science 24.3 / Composite 24.6

Lourdes average ACT scores are consistently above the state and national averages.
