### **Meeting Minutes**

Emilee Yost was the top individual raffle ticket seller, and Hunter Lackey was runner-up.

**Old Business:** Mr. Feilmeier briefly discussed with the group that the Elementary students will be starting the One School-One Book program this coming February. There is still discussion about coordinating activities with the Nebraska City Public School to support a community wide program for the elementary kids. There will be more information regarding this upcoming program to be sent home with the students closer to time.

As a group there was a quick feedback and recap about the recent activities, Trunk or Treat, Soup Supper and Grandparent's Day, that have taken place this year with regards to ideas from parents and teachers to help make these activities run smoother and be a greater success.

**New Business:** LEPTO will be donating an American Girl Doll for the silent auction for the 2017 Lourdes Event this coming spring. The LEPTO Spring Fundraiser was briefly discussed with ideas that could be considered including: Schwans, Red Wheel, Plant Sale and Fan Wear (T-shirts). It was suggested that maybe there could be an email via Survey Monkey sent out to generate some more ideas from parents for our upcoming spring fundraiser.

Mr. Feilmeier introduced the new Lourdes Central Catholic Advancement Director, Mr. Mike Alex. He gave a brief description of his background and some of his responsibilities and things to come for this school year.

It was motioned for LEPTO to reimburse the school \$254.05 for the lunches that were provided to the guests that attended Grandparent's Day. The motion was made and it was approved by all.


It was also motioned for LEPTO to pay the \$465 per year video licensing fee for the school to use. The motion was made and approved by all.
