Lourdes Central Catholic has been blessed with several generous donors and is able to award the following scholarships.

1. **The Blessed Mother Teresa Scholarship.** This scholarship will be awarded to the student who has participated in numerous community service projects both in and out of school. **Amount: (1) \$1000 or (2) \$500**
2. **The Saint John Bosco Scholarship.** This scholarship will be awarded to the overall well rounded student. This includes the areas of academics, service, and activities. **Amount: (1) \$1000 or (2) \$500**
3. **The Saint Francis of Assisi Scholarship.** This scholarship will be awarded to the student with the most financial need. **(1) \$1000 or (2) \$500**
4. **The Charlotte, Theodore, and Jerome Wirth Memorial Scholarship.** This will be awarded to the overall well rounded student. This includes the area of academics, service, and activities. **Amount: (1) \$500**
5. **The Thomas A Neyens Memorial Scholarship.** This will be awarded to a student going into the field of medicine. **Amount: (1) \$100**
6. **Pumpkin Ridge Memorial Scholarship.** This will be awarded to the overall well rounded student. This includes the area of academics, service, and activities. **Amount varies**
7. **Our Lady of Lourdes Scholarship.** This will be awarded to any applicant who isn't awarded one of the scholarships listed above. **Amount: \$150**

All interested students need to provide the following:

1. An introductory page that includes your name and which scholarships you would like to be considered for. Also include how many children in your family are currently in college or attending a Catholic school grades K-12. If you would like to be considered for the Saint Francis of Assisi Scholarship you must also include what your family's adjusted gross income was for last year.
2. A current resume
3. An essay that addresses "What Lourdes Central Catholic has given to you and what you have given to our school."
4. If you are applying for the Thomas A. Neyens Scholarship you must submit an essay on why you are going into the field of medicine.

All applications should be submitted to the Guidance Office by April 1st.
